



2026/2027 Funding Priorities

Early Care and Education

1. Increase the quality of teacher/child interactions in the classroom.
2. Increase equitable access to high quality early care and education.
3. Educator Education Levels & ECE Workforce Development

Health

1. Increase access to developmental enrichment and early intervention for children with special needs, with emphasis for 3 – 5 years
2. Address the health and wellbeing of young children, with an emphasis on well-child visits.
3. Remove barriers that create disparities in maternal and infant health outcomes.
4. Support social-emotional needs for children at-risk of preschool suspension and/or expulsion. (Circle of Parents, TA Consulting & training.)

Family Support

1. Increase parenting skills among parents/caregivers.
2. Offer navigation support to link families to services, with an emphasis on services for children with special health care needs.
3. Family Engagement & Leadership

Early Literacy

1. Support activities that develop and promote evidence based emergent literacy.
